### Two open windows that should mobilize us:

1. The first window of opportunity - is the loss of certainty.
2. A second window of opportunity is the lack of community

### Evangelism is categorized in two ways:

1. Confrontational - Romans 1:16
2. Relational

Every method of not evangelizing is wrong and many methods of evangelizing are right.

A third way...Spirit led.

*Colossians 1:28 (ESV) <sup>28</sup> Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. <sup>29</sup> For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me.*
