Camp hours are 9:00am to 3:30pm

Before Care is offered from 8:00am-9:00am for an additional \$20/week (\$16/week for 4-day weeks) and After Care is offered from 3:30pm-5:00pm for an additional \$25/week (\$20/week for 4-day weeks). You may register for Before Care only, After Care only or both Before and After Care.

Kitchener Campers

Kitchener campers will be bused from our Kitchener site (600 Doon Village Rd.) to our Cambridge site for camp every day. **Ensure you choose this option during registration.**

Drop off at the Kitchener site from 8:30am to 8:45 and pick up between 4:15pm and 4:30pm. This bus costs \$5/week/child. The bus will leave from Kitchener at 8:45am.

Types of Camp

Camp Forward offers 3 kids camps at our Cambridge location with a bus from our Kitchener location.

- Kindergarten Camp: Campers in Junior and Senior Kindergarten in the 2023-2024 school year. Kindergarten camp will be divided into groups. Each group will participate in the same program. If you are registering with a friend or a sibling and they would like to be together, please ensure you select the same group for them. Please note that it is not guaranteed as the groups are subject to change.
- 2. Elementary Camp: Campers in Grades 1-5 in the 2023-2024 school year. Elementary camp will be divided into groups. Each group will participate in the same program. If you are registering with a friend or a sibling and they would like to be together, please ensure you select the same group for them. Please note that it is not guaranteed as the groups are subject to change.
- 3. Adaptive Camp: This camp is specifically designed for children who would benefit from additional support. Examples could include special needs, physical disabilities, mental health and trauma. Campers in this camp will have a program specifically designed for them and their needs while also spending some time in the mainstream camps. Please note this camp is taking the place of the 1:1 support we have offered in previous summers as this new structure will allow a better experience for campers who need some additional support and allow us to help more families. If you would like your child to be fully included in the mainstream camps, you are welcome to provide your own 1:1 support staff who must be preapproved by Camp Forward, and your camper will come for free. Please note that a spot in Adaptive Camp is not guaranteed as Camper safety is our top priority and we do have staffing limitations as to the number of adaptive campers we are able to support.
