KEY VERSE: "LORD, may glory be given to you, not to us. You are loving and faithful." Psalm 115:1 (NirV)

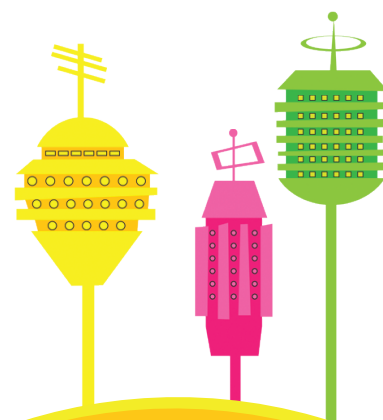
READ IT!

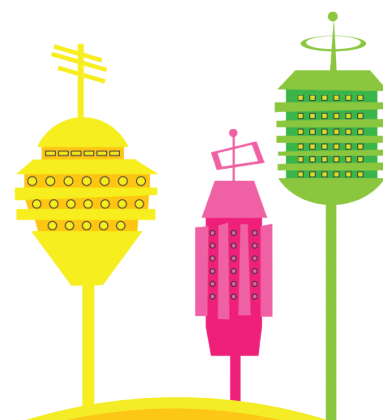
READ IT!
