### Challenge



Interview a married couple this week about their marriage (maybe your parents?). Find out how they met, and where they were married. What do you want to know about marriage? Ask them.

Memorize Proverbs 10:1 this week.

### Challenge

Do something each day this week to honor your parents. It could be something as simple as doing your homework or your chores without them having to remind you. Do your best to make your relationship with your parents peaceful and joyful all week!



We finished our series called Designed by God. Not every family includes multiple children. You may not have a sibling, but God designed that relationship and has called those with siblings to love each other.
