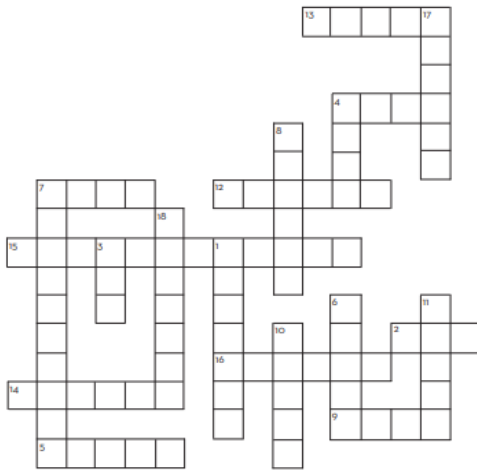

ANIMALS IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

ACROSS

- Instead of killing his son, Abraham sacrificed this animal (Genesis 22).
- These animals were foretold to devour Jezebel's body so that no man could identify her corpse (2 Kings 9).
- Because Pharaoh refused to believe Moses about God, this hopping hoard of animals was sent as a plague (Exodus 8).
- God's instructions to Moses about the Passover detailed that the blood sprinkled on the doorframe could be from one of two animals: a sheep or a ____ (Exodus 12).
- Samson defeated this animal, and days later found it to be filled with honey (Judges 14).
- He was thrown into the lion's den (Daniel 6).
- He was swallowed by a giant fish when he tried to run away from God (Jonah 1).
- A pair of these animals and a vine are the stars of this parable (Ezekiel 17).
- As part of his job, David killed both a lion and a bear in order to protect this precious commodity (3 words) (1 Samuel 17).
- When God commanded this man to hide in the ravines, he sent ravens to help feed him (1 Kings 17).

- The animal is often blamed for the downfall of man (Genesis 3).
- When interpreting Pharaoh's dream, Joseph claimed that the seven of what animal predicted famine? (Genesis 41).
- This type of bird brought an olive branch back to the ark (Genesis 8).
- When wandering the desert, God sent manna and this animal for Moses and his followers to eat (Exodus 16).
- Aaron, Moses' brother, made the mistake of creating this type of idol (2 words) (Exodus 32).
- A stubborn animal, this beast saw an angel of the Lord before his master, Balaam, did (Numbers 22).
- God created the animals on this day (Genesis 1).
- The first bird Noah sent out of the ark (Genesis 8).
- To ensure a victory in battle, David cut these animals' ham strings so they could no longer pull a chariot (2 Samuel 8).
- An army of these is said to make the "earth shake" at the mere mention of their name (Joel 2).
